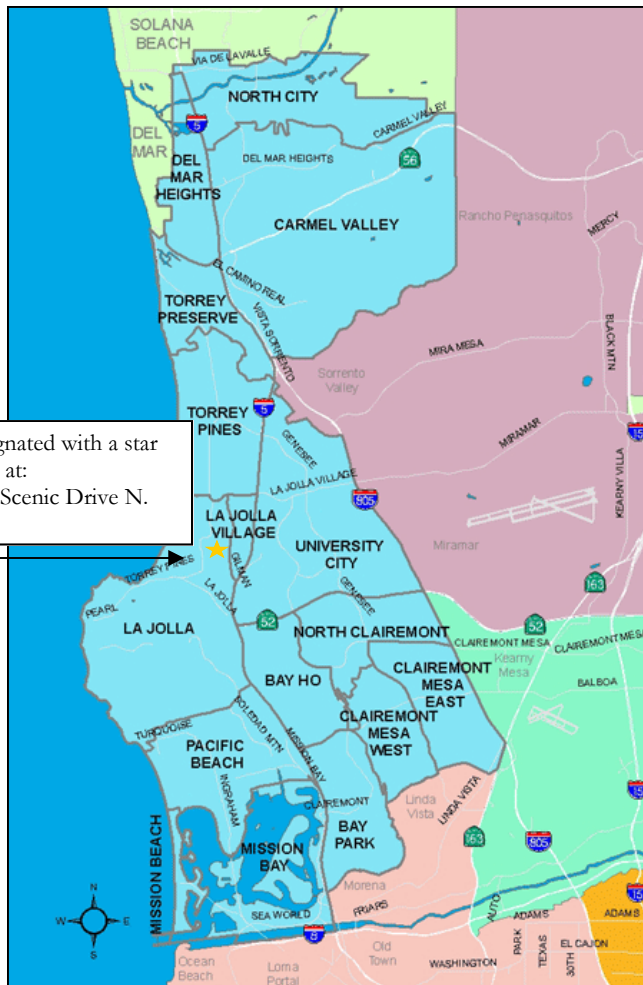


Housing Information

The purpose of this document is to give you a guide as a resource in your search for housing by giving you information about neighborhoods in La Jolla and San Diego close to the training center, transportation, and some websites to use in your search for housing.
