General Requirements:

- Prior to submitting an application and resume for a Team Staff position, applicant must have passed a
 background check via the National Center for Safety Initiatives. (For additional information on this requirement,
 contact rporter@usarollersports.org)
- All Team Staff Members must hold current membership in USA Roller Sports
- Team Staff Members must be available to travel with the team to and from the event.
- A resume of sporting experience must be submitted with this application or already be on file at USA Roller Sports. *This application, however, must be submitted annually.*
- Agree to Abide by the USOC Code of Ethics

Additional Sports Specific Requirements and Responsibilities:

Coaches must be recognized as a USARS Elite Coach or Advanced Coach.

Considerations:

- Gender Representation An effort will be made to include female staff members for all female teams (and vice versa for men's teams) and both male and female staff members for mixed gender teams.
- Team Managers must be able to manage the transportation, housing and finances of team and provide a detailed financial accounting of any team funds provided for use.
- Must have the ability to work well with elite athletes, other staff members and in high-pressure situations
- Support of USA Roller Sports programs domestically through involvement
- Preference may be given to demonstrated international experience
- Consideration may be given to the applicant's status with potential World Team members, either as personal coach or family member.
- An effort will be made to rotate these positions among various qualified candidates every two years.

Selection Procedure:

The appropriate Sport Committee for each Skating Sport (Speed Skating, Roller Figure Skating, Rink Hockey and Inline Hockey) shall review the applications received by the designated deadline and provide their recommendations for team staff members to the USARS Executive Committee for final approval. (For Speed Skating, a list of situational questions is given to each applicant for written response. Points are awarded by each member of the Speed Committee for each answer. Results are tallied and the committee's recommendations are forwarded for approval.)

Specific Staff Responsibilities: A copy can be requested by contacting USA Roller Sports.

By my signature below, I hereby acknowledge that I have reviewed the USA Team Staff Responsibilities and if selected will complete them to the best of my ability.

I further agree to abide by the rules of USA Roller Sports, the Federation International de Roller Sports and the United States Olympic Committee.
