Patrick D. Henderson, Director of Regulatory Affairs, Marcellus Shale Coalition

The Marcellus Shale Coalition is the largest advocacy organization representing operators and affiliated companies involved in the development of natural gas in the Commonwealth. As Director of Regulatory Affairs, Henderson assists the members of the Marcellus Shale Coalition in navigating a host of important public policy issues which affect the safe and responsible development of shale gas resources. He is also a member of the Pennsylvania Climate Change Advisory Committee.

Prior to this role, Henderson served as
Deputy Chief of Staff and Energy
Executive for Governor Tom Corbett.
From January 1999 through January 18, 2011,
Henderson served as the Executive Director of
the Senate Environmental Resources and
Energy Committee.

Henderson led the effort to publish Pennsylvania's first ever-State Energy Plan, published in January 2014. He also helped craft and seek enactment of Act 13 of 2012, the comprehensive Marcellus Shale law which updated the state's oil and gas statutes for the first time in nearly three decades.


