



Catholic Education University Grant Certification Form

Students who completed their full education at a Catholic school (either K-12 or 9-12) in the Archdiocese of Detroit will receive a Catholic Education University Grant when they enroll as full-time, first-time students at University of Detroit Mercy beginning Fall 2016.

To qualify for the elementary portion, an elementary school official must certify that the student completed their full elementary school education (grades 1-8). Students are required to have completed eight years at a Catholic elementary school to qualify.

Secondary school transcripts will be used to certify a student’s full secondary education (grades 9-12) at a Catholic school. Students are required to have completed four years at a Catholic secondary school to qualify.
