In this small group environment as parent/s you will:

- Learn the evidence based stages of healthy development, understand your own child's developmental profile, and how to use the developmental levels as a roadmap for setting goals.
- Understand: your own child's unique sensory processing profile, ways that sensory processing dysfunction can impact on development, and ways to deal with sensory processing challenges.
- Learn about how language develops, explore your own child's unique language profile, and how to support your child's range of communicative functions.
- Get ideas for managing to support your children to stay regulated, manage tricky behaviors, and get ideas on how to deal with daily challenges.
- Discuss ways to support family functioning and quality of family life while adjusting to meeting the demands of parenting a child with exceptional needs.
