Dear Parents,
We begin this week with a visit from OMSI Monday morning. This workshop lets the children design and test their own marble coaster, complete with loops and jumps! They will solve engineering challenges through design and testing. This workshop helps us to cover the Oregon State Science Standards in engineering and design.

Please note that the Talent Show is coming up. Thursday, April $14^{\text {th }}$. If your child wants to participate (and many second graders do!) his /her form needs to be in by this Tuesday, April 5. It's not too late to join in with another group or choose to do your own thing.

In spelling we are studying the digraphs "ew" as in new and "ui" as in fruit. It's the same sound (one of the two long $u$ sounds) as last week but we are using different letters to make the same sound. Earlier this year we learned to write the same sound using "u" and the "magic e" e.g. tube. There are yet other ways to write the same sound e.g "ough" like in through.

In math, we will continue to measure time. Students will practice telling time to the five minutes as well as learning different ways to say the time. This week we will also measure length using the metric system (centimeters and meters) and learn more about measuring weight and capacity.

In social studies we will practice budgeting money. Your children already seem to be very aware of the need to save, of the importance of donating... and of the foolishness of spending without "thinking for a minute" as Aiden said.

The focus in religion is Holy Week and the Eucharist. We learn that through the sacrifice of Jesus we have new life. This ties in with Easter season themes and helps with the preparation for those receiving First Holy Communion soon. Also we begin to prepare to lead Mass on Thursday, April / $4^{\text {th }}$. Your child will choose his /her part in the Mass and if he/she chooses a reading part it will go home in his /her home folder on Friday.
