On the other side of this page is the application form for joining a MSOEs student chapter of the Biomedical Engineering Society (BMES). BMES is the national professional organization for Biomedical Engineers.

### *Vision and Mission*

*To build and support the biomedical community, locally, and nationally, with activities designed to communicate recent advances, discoveries; promote education and professional development; and integrate the perspectives of biomolecular, nursing, mechanical, electrical, computer, and all other majors; and innovative growth through networking.*

Our local chapter holds a number of events on and near campus every year. We do a couple parties and picnics. We have a group on the Hub (<http://www.msoe.edu/groups/biomedical-engineering-society>). We also typically visit the Medical College of Wisconsin (MCW) and one or more medical device companies each year. The chapter also arranges for speakers of interest to BE students to come to campus.
