



2016 Mission Statement Scholarship Recommendation Request & Submission Details

Created in 2002, the **Chancellor's Office** and **Student Development Services** partner in providing Mission Statement Scholarships totaling \$6,000 each year. Three students (rising seniors) are presented a \$2,000 award at the fall Ring Ceremony in recognition for demonstrating excellence in fulfilling the TCU mission.

RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

Students are asked to submit three letters of recommendation from one of each of the following categories:

1. TCU Faculty Member
2. TCU Faculty Member or Professional Staff Member
3. Anyone Inside or Outside the TCU Community

Recommendations should, as much as possible, address the applicant's qualifications with regard to each point of the TCU Mission Statement: "To educate individuals to think and act as ethical leaders and responsible citizens in the global community."

SELECTION PROCESS

A diverse committee from the TCU community is called on to review applications and provide finalists to the Chancellor and Provost for selection. Members of the committee cannot serve as recommenders for scholarship applicants. Various parts of the application are each scored and weighted as follows:

- Reflective Writing Submission – 60%
- Letters of Recommendation – 30% (10% each)
- Resume Highlights – 10%
