## JACK WATKINS MEMORIAL RESERVE CHURCHILL RD. KILBURN SA

The City of Port Adelaide Enfield have placed a Memorial Walkway leading from car-park to the original Memorial, opened on 30<sup>th</sup> August 2003. The Jack Watkins Reserve was set up to honour those that worked at the old Islington Railway Workshops. There will be 100 m2 of pavers within the walkway, each being capable of being replaced by your special paver in memory of your lost one. Each paver is 400mm x 400mm

The Memorial Walkway was officially opened during the Asbestos Victims Memorial Day Service on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2011. Both the Premier of South Australia (Hon Jay Weatherill) and the Mayor of the City of Port Adelaide Enfield (Gary Johanson) officiated during the Asbestos Victims Memorial Day Service
