3. **AAU membership required:** \$14.00 youth, \$27.00 adult.
4. Proper competitor attire must be worn.
 - Traditional solid white gi (no rolled sleeves/cuffs/stripes/piping etc.)
 - Pants and sleeves must cover 2/3rd of the leg and arm.
 - An **AAU patch is required** to be worn on the left chest area, no other patches will be allowed.
 - No attire under the gi will be permitted except a white sports shirt for women.
 - No headband, jewelry, or hair accessories.
5. Sparring equipment. (**NEW AAU RULE**) Clear/white plastic breast protectors and white chest and rib protectors are optional for all youth athletes, and must be worn under the gi. White fist guards of naugahyde material (Kamikaze, Adidas of Tokaido brands are recommended, **no** cloth guards will be permitted) and mouth guards are required for all ages. Groin cup protector required for all boys and men. White, head gear **with face shield** is required for all youths 18 years old and under. White cloth shin/instep pads optional.
6. Only four belts will be allowed at the tournament:
Beginner-white; Novice-green, Intermediate-brown; Advanced-black.
7. Age requirements: The age and time in training of the competitors as of July 1st shall determine the age and experience of that competitor as regards to the competition for the entire year.
8. Rules: AAU Referee dress code: Coat & Tie
9. At the discretion of the tournament director a division may be combined or subdivided according to height and weight. In junior age divisions a single competitor who is significantly larger or smaller than the other competitors in his/her division may be moved up or down one and only one age division.
