ACTIVATING PRIOR KNOWLEDGE- READING STRATEGY!

Each fortnight our school will be focusing on a reading comprehension strategy as a part of our whole school reading plan. We will be modelling the strategy for students in a whole class lesson. following up with shared group reading as well as practising the skill in our guided reading and independent reading lessons. With a focus across the whole school we are trying to develop a consistent language and approach to developing comprehension. Why comprehension? Our data says that our students are fantastic decoders. We can read the words. It is the next level of making meaning and understanding texts that we need to develop.

Our strategy for the fortnight is activating prior knowledge.

Prior knowledge is the unique set of knowledge each individual student brings to the reading experience. It is a combination of the student's attitudes and knowledge.

By knowledge we mean:-

- What the student already knows about the reading process
- Vocabulary knowledge •
- Topic knowledge
- Concept knowledge •
- Text type or genre and the language features

By activating prior knowledge students are able to connect with what they already know. This gives them a base on which to build further knowledge. Please ask your child (Years 2-7) about the TV (text / Visual strategy) that we have been focusing on.

With this weeks newsletter I have also included an updated copy of our reading comprehension strategy cards. Please peruse and if you have any questions please see your child's classroom teacher. We are also introducing SCORE to support our reading program. I will have some more information about this next week.
