With the support of our volunteers and donors we are able to offer a number of on-going activities and educational projects to the local community in and around Ruhanga in SW Uganda. It's a rural area; many villagers are single women caring for orphans and young children and most are subsistence farmers with little or no cash income.

We run a small not-for-profit guesthouse and this enables visitors & volunteers to stay in the area and work with the local community. The villagers asked us to start a school and through our sponsorship scheme we are now educating over 400 children at a minimal charge. All our students receive a free daily breakfast plus school uniforms kindly donated by UK schools. In total we now employ around 30 permanent staff and many other tradesmen on an ad-hoc basis. Visitors and volunteers are welcome to stay with us for short or longer periods at a cost of only £70 per week full board. Our guests generally help at our school, the local hospital or within the community; we also organise safaris and gorilla treks for many of our visitors at very reasonable rates.

As well as new school classrooms, donations and the profits from our Guest House have enabled us to provide clean fresh water to nearby villages and to our own school. Volunteers have also helped to give out 250 free mosquito nets and run several business training skills workshops for unemployed villagers. This year, thanks to funding from ASE Consulting, we are building a village Medical Centre. Future plans include constructing two new classrooms and a school hall, followed by a vocational training centre to offer courses such as mechanics, tailoring, carpentry, and building work.

To sponsor a teacher costs £50 a month and a child just £3.50p Additional funding from our donors allows us to employ many different local builders, and purchase sand, cement, iron sheets etc. and timber for making shelves, desks and tables. Aside from direct donations all the profits from our volunteer's accommodation and the safaris we run goes towards upgrading and expanding these projects.
