

Continuous Point Sparring

Continuous Sparring is best meant for the more experienced sparring competitors. It is open to all competitors, but we recommend only experienced sparring competitors should compete in continuous divisions.

Here's how it works

Each match consists of two, 30 second rounds. The same rules are in place as in regular point sparring with the following exceptions: All penalties are 2-5 points. 2 point penalty for running out of the ring or falling to the ground to avoid the fight, 2 point penalty for more than 3 hand techniques in a row, 2 point penalty for face or groin contact, 3-5 points (center referee discretion) for excessive contact, hitting after the break or striking a downed opponent. But, instead of breaking for each point, the sparring is continuous until the end of the round. During the round, corner judges are tracking points scored on a hand held clicker. The center referee is in charge of the ring. He or she is responsible to keep good control of the action and only breaks the action to award penalty points, restart a match in bounds, or when one fighter goes to the ground, there is **no ground fighting**. The four corner judges score the match in the following way. In round 1, two judges are assigned to watch and score fighter "A" while the other two score fighter "B". At the end of round 1 the scores are tabulated. In round two the judges switch who they are scoring. At the end of round two scores are tabulated. Round 1 and round 2 scores and penalties are added up to decide the winner. In case of a tie the competitors go to a first point wins, sudden victory overtime, same as point sparring.

Point Sparring Rules

All Point Sparring and Forms divisions will adhere to the 2011 CKA Rules (See CKA website for full set of rules...www.coloradokarateassociation.org)

Coaching: Coaching is allowed in all sparring divisions. The coach must have a valid coaching pass and must wear it in plain view while inside the competition area.

Bracketing: In order to be as fair as possible to all competitors, bracketing will be done by random draw at ringside.

Point Sparring

Point Values to any legal target: One point is scored for a hand strike or body kick. Two points are scored for a controlled kick to the head or spinning kick to the body. 3 points for any spinning kick to the head, or jump spinning kick to a legal target area.

Legal Target Areas: Head & Face, Sides of Neck, Chest, Abdominal Area, Torso, Kidneys. The Groin is a legal target in adult Intermediate and above divisions only.

Illegal Target Areas: Throat, Back of Neck, Spine, Legs, Knees, Head on a downed opponent.

Warnings and Penalties for Illegal Techniques: 1st infraction receives a warning, 2nd, opponent receives 1 point, 3rd is automatic disqualification. Ring officials may waive a warning and issue either a penalty point, or decide to disqualify the offender immediately. Running out of bounds is an automatic "point over" to opponent. All competitors must wear mouthpieces, groin cups mandatory for all male competitors.

TEAM FORMS

Team Forms gives schools a chance to have their students compete together!

Each team consists of 2 to 10 competitors and will follow the Open Musical Form rules. Music is allowed, as are gymnastics, weapons, and props. There is a 3 minute time limit for Team Forms.

Flying Dragons and Handicapable Divisions

The Flying Dragons Division is meant for those Karate kids 5 years and younger who are not quite ready for the 6 and under division; a great way to introduce the younger Karateka to competition.

The Handicapable division allows our challenged competitors to showcase their talents.

The cost of either the Flying Dragons or Handicapable division is the same as an additional division.
