General Rules

- 1. We are Television Spaceman Limited.

However, you acknowledge that neither we nor anyone else involved in the production or promotion of the Series shall be responsible to you for any failure to maintain such secrecy, or for the loss of any protections or rights under any intellectual property laws arising as a result of such failure or the Series or any related publicity.
- 15 If we wish to publicise your invention before the Series goes to air we will contact you first to obtain your permission.

Return of your invention

16 If you give us your invention we will return it to you at the end of production of the Series and all related publicity. We will try to take reasonable care of your invention while it is in our possession, but we will not be responsible for any damage to it.
