Application Process

- 1. Complete all sections of the application, including doctrinal statement. Wives and fiancés need to complete the appropriate application as well.
- 2. Return the applications to Baptist Church Planters.
- 3. It is your responsibility to send out both Pastors' Personal Reference Forms and Personal Reference Forms to all those you have listed on the applications. Be sure to include a return envelope addressed to:

- 4. After all the references are received, all documentation is sent to our Applications Committee for review. (This is where the process slows down. Be sure to follow up with your references.)
- 5. The Applications Committee will arrange a doctrinal interview as part of the evaluation process.
- 6. When the Applications Committee approves you to move forward, we will notify you.
- 7. An invitation to Candidate Class will be sent to you.
- 8. Upon completion of Candidate Class, you will meet with the Council for a general time of questioning before final approval. If you are married, your wife will meet with the Council at the same time.

Article V – MISSIONARIES

Section 1. Candidates

A. Qualifications. Candidates for missionary service with Baptist Church Planters must be **born again and spiritually mature** men or women who have been baptized by single immersion, who are members in good standing in a Baptist church that is not affiliated with any apostate or liberal organization, or any Convention of churches, and who give evidence of a call to the ministry.

It is preferred that applicants have a minimum of three (3) years formal training in a Bible institute, college or seminary, and some practical experience in Christian service. It is not required that male applicants be ordained. No divorced person will be accepted as a missionary. An exception may be made for Missionary Builders at the recommendation of the Board of Directors of ChurchCare.

- B. Applications. Those who desire to serve with this Mission Agency will be asked to complete and submit an application for the ministry to which they are applying. All applicants will be interviewed by the Council, required to attend candidate school and fulfill other stated contingencies. Applicants must also be authorized and commissioned by the church of which they are members before final approval. Both husband and wife are considered missionaries when approved so both need to submit separate applications and meet the above stated requirements. BCP will not process applications from potential missionaries from foreign countries unless they have obtained appropriate authorization from the U.S. Government to obtain legal employment in the United States.
- C. Applications Committee. The Candidate Coordinator will keep the Applications Committee informed of all applications. A committee of *at least* three (3) members of the Council shall be appointed to serve on the Applications Committee. This committee shall carefully examine all applications for missionary service and recommend to the Council those whom they are convinced qualify to serve with Baptist Church Planters.
- D. Examination of the Candidates. The Council shall be furnished with a completed file of each candidate who has been approved by the Applications Committee, including the Committee's written recommendation.

The Council shall meet with each candidate for a personal interview in order to determine his/her qualifications for missionary service. Candidates will be expected to relate his/her own salvation experience, baptism by immersion, call to the ministry and doctrinal position.

Candidates approved for missionary service will be approved with the following contingencies: attending Candidate School, deputizing adequate support, and commissioning by a sending church. They will also be expected to sign the Mission's doctrinal statement (annually), Missionary Agreement, and abide by the policies of the Mission Agency and any other special requirement the Council may deem necessary.
