PANAMA CANAL

While there are many canals throughout the world, the Panama Canal is not simply a passage but it embodies the dream of a continent. Just as explorers searched for centuries for the Northwest passage, many were also looking for a new shipping route to replace the long and treacherous route around Cape Horn, and connect the Atlantic to the Pacific Ocean.

During transit, a ship is raised or lowered 85 feet in a continuous flight of three steps at Gatun Locks. Each lock chamber is only 110 feet wide and 1,000 feet long – so sailing precision is paramount! To assist, railway tracks run alongside the canal and rail cars use cables that connect to the ship on either side and keep it in place.



At the end of the first set of locks is Gatun Lake,

it supplies the water necessary to operate the locks. The water runs downhill from this man-made lake to fill the locks. No pumps, no power, just the force of gravity!

NAIRN DUNBAR GOLF CLUB: It is a challenging championship golf course on the Moray Firth, a traditional Scottish Links Course voted as Scottish Golf Club of the Year in 2015.

DUFF HOUSE ROYAL GOLF CLUB: Suited to golfers of all abilities, play takes you along meticulously manicured park-like greens. Be careful – the River Deveron has claimed many a ball!

CULLEN GOLF CLUB: Along the Moray Firth Coast, this 18-hole course is one of Scotland's oldest. Founded in 1870, its location is one of the most remarkable – and memorable – in Europe.

ALYTH GOLF CLUB: Winner of a Scottish Tourism Award, this 18-hole course was established in 1894. The tree-lined fairways are tranquil yet challenging, boasting 6,259 yards of play.





CULLEN GOLF COURSE

Cullen is a traditional Scottish links course in the northeast of Scotland, founded in 1870 as a 9-hole course laid out by old Tom Morris and later upgraded to 18 holes by Charlie Neaves.

Cullen lays claim to the most remarkable site for a golf course in Europe. There isn't a lot of room within this amazing environment for Cullen's 18 holes, with the course playing its outward nine close to the cliffs and the inward nine playing back at beach level. A seaside links course incorporating many blind shots. Cullen offers great views of the coastline and over the Moray Firth. Watch for dolphins!

The unbridled thrill of the course lies in its par 3s. A quartet of short holes from the 11th to the 14th is the highlight of the back nine and each features the 80ft. Boar Crag. The 12th and 13th are the most exciting, playing directly over this rusty red colossus, which completely blocks the greens from view. You could easily play two rounds without entertaining thoughts of the 19th on this immaculately kept course. When you do tire of this uncomplicated and refreshing layout, head into the clubhouse for a bowl of "Cullen Skink". The creamy white chowder for which the region is famed is as pleasantly surprising as the golf course.



Overlooking the Canadian battlefield of 1917 – at one of the points of the fiercest fighting – stands the Canadian National Vimy Memorial. The names of the 11,285 Canadian soldiers who were posted "missing or presumed dead" in France are inscribed on the ramparts. Use of the land for all time was granted to Canadians by France, with the Memorial unveiled by King Edward VIII on July 26, 1936. Most of the wartime tunnels lacing the grounds are closed off from the public, due to safety concerns, but a portion of the Grange Subway has been preserved and can be experienced with the assistance of Canadian interpretive guides. Today, the Canadian National Vimy Memorial symbolizes Canada's commitment to world peace, liberty and the rule of international law. A journey to Vimy Ridge is a memorable and life-changing experience for all Canadians.





MENIN GATE MEMORIAL TO THE MISSING

54,896 Commonwealth soldiers who died during World War I have no known grave. The massive Menin Gate Memorial to the Missing is a tribute to these men. Located at the point at which soldiers would have marched to the front lines, the Memorial is a symbol of Ypres gratitude. Each evening at 8 o'clock, buglers from the local fire department close the road and sound the Last Post, a tradition that dates back to 1928.

IN FLANDERS FIELDS MUSEUM

Located in the centre of Ypres, Belgium and named for John MCrae's poem, the 'In Flanders Fields Museum' is dedicated to the study of World War I. In moving retellings of the invasion of Belgium, the trench war and the end of The Great War, the museum is more than just military narration. Visitors can climb the bell tower and gaze across the century-old battlefield or sit and reflect quietly. 
