Any 4-H member, or group of up to three 4-H members representing a club-based venture, is eligible to apply to -market or sell an *original* product or service.

Youth selling a product (such as cookbooks or quilts) can bring pre-made items to sell at the booth, and/or take customer orders to fill later. State fair regulations do not permit the sale of food or food products at the sales booth (give-away food samples are fine).
