
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PRIMARY SCHOOLS ONE DAY CHESS TOURNAMENT AT TIGS

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Dear Parents and Caregivers,

This semester's concert is scheduled for Thursday of Week 10, the 17th of September 2015.

Once again, all students will have already seen the show during the day; this leaves the whole hall free for families to attend the evening performance.

We are selling tickets to the show at \$5 a seat for seats inside the hall, \$3 for seating under the hall COLA and \$2 for standing at the back of the hall COLA. These will need to be pre-bought at the office. (First in best seated.) NO TICKETS SOLD AT THE DOOR.

We would also ask that if you have not purchased a ticket to sit inside, that you do not come and stand on the sides of the seats, as this restricts access for teachers and students to get onto the stage.

Those students who are involved in the show will be looked after in their classrooms for the entire length of the concert and must not be picked up early and bought to the hall area. (Any student who is not appearing in the concert and comes to school on the evening must have a booked seat.)

The groups that will be appearing in the concert are **Junior and Southern Stars Dance Group**. The following classes will also perform 3C, KFC, 6J, 5/6A, 1/2L, 1/2P, 3/4E, 4H, 2B, 3/4D and 5/6B.
