Type of Class Definitions:

Read the following to decide which box fits your 'Type of Course' selection for page one of this form:

Concurrent Enrollment

This box should be checked for online, contracted, or career academy classes in which the local school district has an approved contract with the community college for specific courses in which the student wishes to enroll. The student's high school counselor and/or principal should know which courses have been requested under contract agreements with the college.

PSEO (Post Secondary Enrollment Option).

This box should be checked for on campus courses only (at ECC, MCC, or IVCC Grinnell). The high school has given approval for the student to enroll in the course and the school district agrees to pay up to \$250 of the associated costs. Any costs exceeding \$250 are paid by the community college.

Self-Pay

This box should be checked if the high school has given approval for the student to enroll in the course, as long as the student pays the tuition, fees and other associated costs such as books, etc. A student may choose to "self-pay" for additional credits beyond the 23 credits that a school district may receive supplemental weighting. All expenses are the responsibility of the student and his/her parent/guardian.

PSEO Course(s) Only - Please read:

281 IAC- 22.3 requires that a student who anticipates enrollment under the Postsecondary Enrollment Act must inform the school district of the intent to participate and that the school district shall inform the students of the availability of the opportunity provided by the Act 281-IAC 22.6 requires the pupil, if over eighteen years of age, or pupil's parent, guardian, or custodian to reimburse the school district for all costs directly related to all incomplete and non-credit course work. In addition, materials that become the property of student will be charged. An eligible postsecondary institution should make pro-rate adjustments to tuition reimbursement based upon federal guidelines established pursuant to 20 U.S.C § 1091b. The textbook cost is included in the \$250 PSEO tuition. Textbooks are property of IVCCD and must be returned to IVCCD at the completion of the course.
