

## Accreditation Statements

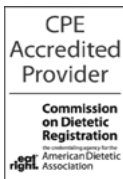
**Doctors of Osteopathy:** Category 2 credit will be awarded for formal educational programs that are ACCME-accredited or AAFP – approved.

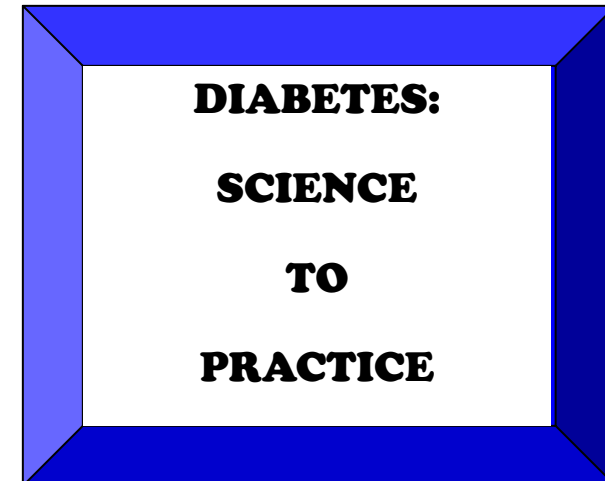
