

Master Class in Baroque Violin with Enrico Onofri

The class is designed for students, musicians and auditors.

The opening will take place on 16 September 2013 at 3 p.m. at the Chesa da Cultura on Lake St. Moritz, with the final concert on 21 September 2013 at 8.30 p.m.

Enrico Onofri was born in Ravenna, Italy. While still a student he was invited by J.Savall as concertmaster of La Capella Reial, and also performed with such ensembles as Concentus Musicus Wien, Ensemble Mosaiques, and Concerto Italiano. He has been concertmaster, soloist and co-founder of Il Giardino Armonico since 1987. Since 2002 Enrico Onofri has also appeared with great success as a conductor, receiving invitations from orchestras and festivals throughout Europe and in Japan. In 2000 he founded the chamber ensemble Imaginarium. In 2005 he became principal conductor of Divino Sospiro. E. Onofri has performed in the world's foremost concert halls and received the most prestigious international prizes. Since 2000 he has taught Baroque violin and Baroque performing practice at the Conservatorio Bellini in Palermo.

Cembalist **Johannes Keller** has completed his studies at the Schola Cantorum Basiliensis (with Jörg-Andreas Bötticher and Jesper Christensen). He works with Andrea Marcon and other conductors and regularly holds assistant's jobs with Theatres in Switzerland and Germany. In addition to his own research project on chromatic-enharmonic instruments, his work also focuses on contemporary music.

Tastefully appointed rooms give a beautiful view of the broad and sunny valley of the Engadine on top of the Swiss Alps. Target Group
