Ashley was an excellent student who earned straight A's throughout her school career. Ashley was a member of the FCCLA, where her article about her horse "Lucky," earned her both state and national honors. Ashley was a member of the FFA, where she participated on the horse judging team. She was an active member of the National Barrel Horse Association, Districts Eight and Nine, in which she qualified for the NBHA World Championships four times. At the 2014 National Barrel Horse Association World Championship she set personal record times as a top finalist and finished in sixth place. Ashley was a member of the Bethel Community Church and was recognized by many for her honesty, sincerity, integrity, and her strong Christian faith. Ashley strived to do her best in anything she did and always put others before herself. With a charming personality and a great sense of humor, she never failed to see the good in other people. Ashley was a very sweet girl who touched many lives, and on her last days here on earth she touched 6 others by donating her organs to save their lives, as well as helping many others through numerous bone and tissue transplants.
