All of these thoughts rushed into my mind when I looked into the eyes of Lu, a client waiting in *our own* reception area. She was clearly terrified, her dark eyes speaking louder than any words ever could. I soon realized why—due to a language barrier and misunderstanding about our services, she was under the impression that Life Choices was an abortion clinic, and that moments from now she would be undergoing the terrible procedure. In fact, her husband, who brought her in, said to Christine in his heavy accent "get that baby out". Athough we were shaken by these words, we were also grateful for this providential mistake—here was this baby's chance at life.

Bunny & Jenny first counseled Lu alone (with the help of a telephone interepreter). Soon after they invited in husband John and learned that finances were the determining factor—already struggling with 2 children, there was no way they could afford another. Lu was too earely in her pregnancy for an ultrasound, but Bunny & Jenny appealed to them in so many ways and on so many levels; offering practical, spiritual and material aid, even after the baby was born. But it was hopeless. Their choice was set in stone. Their minds were closed and their hearts were locked. It was a done deal and it was heartbreaking. We watched them leave the Center in earnest search of a "clinic". All we could do was PRAY. And so we did ... very hard and very long, begging the Holy Spirit to intercede on their behalf.

The next morning Bunny took a call from John. "We decided to keep the baby"!!!! Our Hearts soared ... our voices shouted for joy. To God be the glory. Lu's "choice" will bear endless fruit ... and her "body" will bear a beautiful child.

**Please keep both Lu and John in your prayers as they have many challenges ahead. We are continuing to help them every step of the way.

The cause of Life is always an exciting adventure. We make plans and preparations and work diligently towards making them a reality. Our dreams on the other hand, often times get tucked away unknown to anyone but God. **But sometimes, it's God Himself who puts our dreams BEFORE our plans** ... and we humbly submit in stunned silence. Apparently, the Holy Spirit wants us to go "Mobile". This was always a dream, but not an immediate plan. Here is our story as told by

After purchasing four ultrasound machines last year for the Metuchen Diocese, some business people approached the Chapter 4 Knights of Columbus with an offer of several thousand dollars to provide a mobile unit for Life Choices Resource Center in Metuchen. The impact of Hurricane Sandy virtually eliminated most auto dealers for help or donations. But God has His ways. One "cold night in February" State K of C Advocate Tony Moskal agreed to drive me to a distant meeting. On the way we stopped to pick up John Scioscia, who invited us in for a few minutes. We were greeted by visiting Laura and her LARGE German Shepherd by the name of Harley. Being allergic to dogs, I stopped dead in my tracks and opted for a wait in the car with Tony. This gave me time to survey the area where I spotted an RV parked in the neighbor's yard. "Let's steal it and one of our problems would be over" was my loud comment. John answered with "you could just buy it instead, since it's for sale." A conversation with the neighbor revealed that the RV was available and at a reasonable price. Further discussions about the planned use for the RV continued to bring the price lower. After a visit from Jim and Deb Vokral, who enthusiastically approved, the price lowered again and the deal was on. Next was a vote from the Chapter 4 members, who voted and approved the undertaking. From that point, monetary donations flowed in from other Knights of Columbus councils: \$250, \$500, \$1,000, including a \$1,000 match from an individual Knight. Catholic War Veterans Post 405 generously added \$2,000. All these were contributions that were not anticipated and all resulting from an encounter with a dog named Harley.

It will take several months to put the finishing touches on this RV, including something eye-catching for the exterior. Then we will bravely go wherever God leads. We will continue to offer an invitation and an option for **Life and Love** rather than the permanent "choice" that results from a visit to the abortion mill.

Perth Amboy "Helping Hands" Ministry 5 Years Strong

We strive to assist our clients as much as we possibly can even after their babies are born ... or put it this way, especially after their babies are born. Sometimes just the promise of a crib and car seat is enough to put hope into a confused and worried heart. The opportunity to return on a monthly basis and get the supplies one needs to help raise that child is another added bonus. The "Helping Hands" Ministry is thriving thanks to generous donors and hard working volunteers ...

FROM DOT DUNN: The year 2013 found us starting our fifth year of the "Helping" Hands" distribution center at Our Lady of the Rosary of Fatima in Perth Amboy. We started our ministry in 2009 with almost nothing but one rack to hang clothes on and the shelves that Father SedImayer had built for us. We began helping 38 families from local communities and continued to grow from there. We now have 319 active families with 529 children. The inactive families include 451 with 851 children that no longer need diapers. Since opening, we've given away 6, 948 packs of diapers and wipes, hundreds of car seats, strollers, walkers, cribs, high chairs, play packs, clothing (winter and summer) and toys of all kinds. When Christmas was approaching, the big concern was where are we going to get the gifts to give, but God answered our prayers and we were able to give an article of clothing and a toy to each family. Big thanks go to the following groups: St. Matthew's, Edison, Our Lady of Victories, Savreville, Our Lady of Peace, North Brunswick, St. John Vianney, Colonia and many generous individual donors. 2012 was a great year for the Center as we welcomed 73 new babies with layettes. New clothing and other items were made available by the church organizations that have Baby Showers for the Center. We also kept Marge and Jean busy making sweaters and blankets for the newborns. Thanks to all, this year is already turning out to be a great success.
