Project Outline

Students will work under the supervision of the staff at the Kelowna Art Gallery for the Art Break program offered to children during spring break. The student volunteers will assist the instructors with the activities provided each day.

Project Objectives

- The student will gain hands-on experience in implementing and evaluating art activities;
- Students will take on the role of a teacher assistant, under the direction of the Instructor and Public Programming staff;
- The student will enhance the quality of the 'Art Break' program by providing a better instructor to student ratio;
- Students will gain experience in organizing and implementing a community event.

Student Outcomes

The student will learn the following:

- How to become a positive role model (appropriate dress, clean and neat appearance, use of appropriate language, positive and caring attitude towards students and parents);
- How to deal with children in a positive way;
- How to use positive and alternative discipline techniques;
- How to organize and plan techniques for special events;
- How to evaluate activities and the program.

the Work Experience Education Program Placement Agreement forms with signatures. The Orientation will cover 'how to deal with children in a positive and caring way' as well as a general orientation to the gallery. The schedule will be set with input from the students, being as flexible as possible to meet student needs.

March 14 to March 25, 2015

Students will work all or part of spring break. The schedule will be determined at the Orientation.

Student Monitoring

The student will be working directly with the Kelowna Art Gallery staff and program Instructors. They will receive ongoing feedback throughout the placement.
