### HAM RADIO TECHNICIAN LICENSING CLASS – September 22 & 29, 2007

#### Additional Information

You will need to obtain the ARRL book "*Ham Radio License Manual*", First Edition, in order to participate in the class. This is a new book first published for Technician level training beginning on or after July 1, 2006. The old "Now your Talking" manuals are very much out of date and cannot be used as there have been significant changes in the licensing requirements.

Your advance **paid registration** must be received no later than **September 14<sup>th</sup>**. To confirm a reservation for the classes, students must submit their registration form and fee of **\$30** payable to "**MARC**". Mail your check or money order to **James R. Linn, Treasurer, MARC, 5110 Romohr Road, Cincinnati, OH 45244**. Indicate on the check that it is for "Technician Class Fees". Checks must arrive by September 14<sup>th</sup>. Please include your name, mailing address; phone number and email address with your check. **An Application form is attached on the next page.** Fifty Percent (50%) of the registration fee will be forfeited for withdrawals after September 14<sup>th</sup>.

We **strongly recommend** that students read and study the book before classes start. This will make the classes more meaningful and will make it much easier to pass the thirty-five question multiple-choice test. Pass rates are significantly better for students who have pre-studied!

The new book "*Ham Radio License Manual*", First Edition, may be ordered directly from R&L Electronics, 1315 Maple Avenue, Hamilton, OH 45011. If students scroll down the left column of this web site, they will see the category "Practice Tests". Click on that button and then the Technician Button. This will provide students with some excellent opportunities for review and will immensely enhance their chances of passing the real test. There is no charge for using this web site, and students may take the practice tests as many times as they wish. Each practice test is slightly different providing students with practice and review of all of the topics covered in the book.
