The parade will be Saturday, March 17, 2012 at 1:00 P.M. It will start at the north end of town near the Green Feed Store and travel Main Street through Heppner, ending up at the intersection of May and Chase Street. All participants twelve and under receive special recognition.

Saturday morning at 11:30 am, we'll set a sign-in table on the front porch of Green Feed Store. You'll need to check in there to get your parade number and location. If you want to compete for a ribbon, you'll need to be sure to be signed in and in place no later than 12:00 noon. Judging will take place during the parade.

- **This parade is a non-equestrian parade. Please bring your horses to the Fair/ Rodeo Parade in August!**
- **NO CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS ARE TO BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES OR WAGONS. You may walk along and hand candy to people, but no throwing!**

*****NOTE: THIS PARADE IS NON-EQUESTRIAN**

1. All motorized entries must be operated by a licensed driver.
2. Entrants under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
3. NO persons will be allowed to ride on the outside of autos or wagons protected seating inside truck or wagon bed is ok.
4. All entrants agree to maintain suitable insurance which will respond on their behalf and the City's behalf, for any injury or damage which occurs.
5. The entrants also agree they are participating in the parade at their own risk and agree to hold the City harmless for any injury or damage that may occur.
6. All entries must be signed in by noon_
7. **CANDY OR OTHER ITEMS ARE NOT TO BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES OR WAGONS.**
