The only program of its kind in the Susquehanna Valley, the Young Americans Program recognizes the outstanding accomplishments of more than 90 students in twelve participating high schools throughout the Greater Susquehanna Valley for their achievements in academics and extra-curricular activities. Participating high schools select one student each month using the following criteria: must be a high school senior, scholastic achievements, school activities, character and out-of-school participation.

The Chamber and the Young Americans Committee recognizes and promotes the student's excellence through The Daily Item, the Voice of the Valley and Sunbury Broadcasting. Each year, the students participate in an allday seminar that features area business leaders and focuses on topics such as diversity, networking, decision making, finance, goal making and communication.
