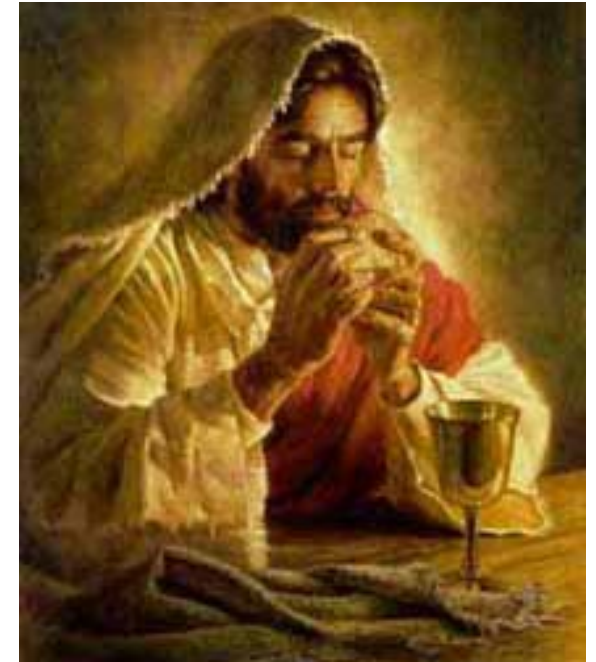

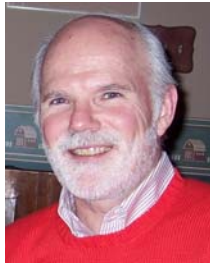
Eucharist in the Workplace: *Becoming What You Receive*
