Job Description

Specific duties will be developed based upon the interests and strengths of the successful candidate, but will include:

- * Plateau Discovery Gardens~assist the CCMGA within the demonstration garden.
- * Lecture~develop and present a mutually agreed upon gardening lecture to the CCMGA membership and/or the annual Fall Gardeners' Festival.
- * Research projects~assist with on-going research including irrigation, weeding, planting, pest management, preparation of seed beds, trellising, composting, fertilizing, using tiller/tools, data collection, and/or other duties as needed.
- * Production log~record day-to-day activities to assist both the candidate and internship sponsors in understanding and improving the internship opportunity.

Eligibility and Selection

Open to any college student, with preference as follows:

- * enrollment in plant sciences and/or related field of study
- * status of upper class person over lower class person

On-site interview to be completed by: February 22, 2013

Notification by: February 28, 2013

Duration: Ten week internship between May 1st and September 1st. Specific start and end dates will be mutually agreed upon between UT PREC Director and Candidate.

Student requirements

Interested applicants must be able to lift 25 pounds, be willing and able to work outdoors, and have a valid driver's license.

Supervision and Coordination

The UT PREC Director and Cumberland County UT Extension Agricultural Agent will be responsible for the supervision of the successful candidate. The successful intern will also meet monthly with members of the selection committee to discuss the experience and progress of the internship opportunity.
