

We are raising money to buy St Alban's a minibus. Please give generously to enable the school to take the children on even more exciting expeditions. All money is subject to <u>Gift Aid</u>, so for every £4 you donate, the school gets £5.



We all know that St Alban's provides our children with an outstanding education and it's great to see that Ofsted now agree. This is not just about what they learn in the classroom but also the amazing breadth of other activities that they do. Many of these are outside the school which presents a problem of transport for getting staff and children around the place. This imposes costs and compromises on what the school can do, as well as creating a lot of work for staff to beg and borrow minibuses from various sources around Cambridge.

We would like to change this by raising enough money to enable the school to get a bus of its own.

It is important that the bus we buy can stand up to the rigours of school life into the future. We are therefore looking to raise $\underline{\text{£10,000}}$ so that we can get a relatively new one with many years of trouble-free life left in it. Every penny is therefore vital to hit this challenging target.

To do this, we would encourage donors to make regular donations via direct debit. If these donations are done through Gift Aid, we reclaim the tax meaning that the school gets 25% more than you donate. Donations of £3, £5, £10, £20 or more per month, together with tax reclaimed, can soon add up. One-off donations are also gladly accepted.

Please take a few minutes to fill in the gift-aided direct debit form overleaf. You can return it confidentially to the school office, in an envelope addressed to the Chairman, St Albans Foundation.

What is the St Alban's Foundation and how does it differ from the PFA?

The Foundation is a registered charity which has raised over £20,000 since it was founded in 2001 to buy equipment and facilities not normally covered by school funding.

Like the PFA, the Foundation has provided the school with a significant amount of money over the years. However, the Foundation does this purely through one-off and regular donations rather than the events run by the PFA that play such a key role in the community of the school. The Foundation is therefore a particularly good way to donate to the school if:

- You cannot give as much time to support the PFA as you would like
- You would like Gift Aid to be recovered on donations (so the school gets £1.25 for every £1 you give)
- You would like to give regular donations to the school
