CANCELLATION DETAILS

Cancellation Date	IMPORTANT: Cancellation within Seven (7) days of Signing Contract, no penalty, thereafter 7 days, penalty loss of deposit. If the User cancels within 30 days prior to the arrival date, the User agrees to pay the GMP.* If the user signs the contract within 7 days of arrival date of the event there will be no refund.

The user assumes full responsibility for its participating guests for any accident, personal injury, or property damage by or to a guest that may occur while staying at Camp Attitude. The User hereby releases and holds harmless, and agrees to defend and indemnify, Camp Attitude Oregon Inc. and its agents, employees and assigns, from any and all claims, liabilities, suits, actions, damages, or losses, attorney fees and/or costs. Camp Attitude requires the User to obtain a Certificate of Insurance covering itself and its guests during their travel and stay at Camp Attitude.

STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

Desiring to create and maintain an accessible camp facility wherein camper accommodations are offered.

We are therefore committed to a Fourfold objective:

- To provide a setting for a week of family fun at a place where you can have fun together in a safe and accepting environment.
- To provide a place where people can experience God's unconditional love and our Creator will be honored and glorified.
- To provide a camp where you can meet and fellowship with others who face similar concerns in life.
- To serve our community, culture and country and be stewards of God's creation.

CAMP RULES

Our guests are asked to comply with a few simple requirements while renting Camp Attitude.

PARKING AND VEHICLES

- All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.
- Parking on driveways and paths is prohibited.
- Parking behind the kitchen is reserved for staff only.
- There is no authorized use of personal off road / motorized recreation vehicles, ie - ATV's, motorcycles, golfcarts, ect.

BUILDINGS / FURNISHINGS / EQUIPMENT

Buildings and grounds are to be left in a clean and orderly manner. Shaving cream, toothpaste and water balloon fights are not permitted in any of the buildings. Candles are not allowed in any cabins. Clean up and damage fees will be assessed and paid at the closing of the event. All furniture and other building equipment must remain in their respective rooms.

DAMAGES

Upon arrival, the group leader may inspect the facilities and notify the Director of any prior damage. Groups will be charged a minimum of \$100 at closing for any cleaning over and above normal group use (see buildings /furnishing/equipment). The group will be charged an additional fee, the normal rate per hour, needed for materials and labor to repair damages. Missing items will be charged at replacement cost.

SMOKING / ALCOHOL / DRUGS

Camp Attitude has a "zero" tolerance policy for alcohol and drugs on the facility grounds. Camp Attitude is a SMOKE FREE Environment, smoking is not permitted in any buildings and can only be allowed in a designated outdoor smoking area. Firearms, or any fireworks (or any pyrotechnic displays) are not permitted on Camp Attitude property.

GARBAGE / RECYCLE

Please deposit all trash in cans provided on the grounds. Recycle containers are also available.

PETS

No Pets are allowed, unless they are a service dog for the disabled and must be accompanied by its owner or on a leash at all times and all doggy doo doo must be picked up.

COURTESY

We ask that you respect your neighbor's and keep the noise levels down after 10:00 p.m

PERSONAL CONDUCT

Respect for others attending the event. All profanity and immoral conduct is unacceptable. Camp Attitude maintains a high level of morals and asks its guests to conduct themselves in a proper accord.

COMMUNICATION

We understand that changes may occur in terms of your group size and other needs for your event. So that we are prepared to serve you better, please keep us informed of these changes.

STATEMENT OF LIABILITY

Camp Attitude's insurance does not cover vehicles (ATV's, dirt bikes, golfcarts ect.) therefore not allowed.
