The In|Site:Ex|Site (ISES) Public Art Program is excited to release a call for entry to Sublette County residents for our 2015 Ex|Site:Cabochon Project.

One artist will be chosen to design a 30" relief medallion, which will be produced in cast iron and permanently imbedded in a sidewalk within the Pinedale community. **The artist will receive a \$500 honorarium for his or her design.** This opportunity is open to permanent Sublette County residents of all ages. The selection process will be by official entry form, which includes a space for a black and white design concept and explanation.

The committee will take into account that this is a preliminary design, and that it may be refined before final approval. It should be noted, however, that a finished and professional design makes it easier for the committee to make a final decision for the winning design. Please keep in mind that the finished installed casting will be viewed from all directions.

ISES reserves the right to reproduce replicas/images for fundraising and marketing efforts to help support the **ISES** public art program.

Entries are due *5pm, February 9th* at the PFAC office on 432 W. Pine Street, across from the Post Office in Pinedale.
