From the Pastor's Desk

Dear friends in Christ;

For those who may have missed mass at St. James last weekend (3/15-16) we had a special speaker talk about a partnership that has been formed between the community of St. James and the Aitkin Children's Center. Julie Miller is the coordinator of the programs offered at the Aitkin Children's Center which shares early childhood programs for infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and their families.

Many of you know how research shows that high quality early childhood programs has a profound impact on a child's social and emotional development as well as their overall cognitive development. This impact extends beyond preschool and well into the early elementary grades. Early childhood is a critical time in a child's development. The activities, experiences, and learning opportunities that a child has during their early years shape their potential for future learning.

Months ago I was frustrated by what was going on with our Rainy Day ministry. We were seeing a run on the charity we were giving out by a very particular demographic of the population. I felt that we were building a sense of entitlement rather than meeting the real needs of these people so I shut the ministry down. I wanted more of a sense of accountability built into our Rainy Day ministry, the old phrase which says, "Give a man a fish and he'll eat for a day... teach a man to fish and he'll eat for a lifetime", was something that was running through my head.

That was when I met Julie Miller at a home football game in Aitkin. The conversation led to more conversation about offering an incentive program for families who attend 6 early childhood programs offered at the Center. And so the <u>Earlier the Better</u> program was conceived and is now in place for mothers and fathers (families) who benefit from the education and guidance given at the Center. The charity these families receive as an incentive to their participation is a \$50 gift certificate to either Shopko or Paulbeck's. These certificates clearly state no cigarettes, scratch-offs or soda but food, gas and other essentials are (of course) ok. An individual can receive up to (4) gift certificates in a year provided they attend the required number of sessions to receive all four which would be (24) sessions.

I reported that we now have \$3,355.00 in our Rainy Day Fund and that the white and blue envelopes appear every month in your box. If everyone gave just a little, this fund would sustain itself nicely. I also said that the first priority of the fund is to help any parishioner in need. So if you are in a bind with anything and you need assistance with food, gas, or even bills don't hesitate to ask for help; that is what the Rainy Day Fund is for; first priority parishioners, second priority Earlier the Better.

I want to publicly thank Julie Miller for making this all happen and to you for your generosity to the Rainy Day Fund. Look for an article in this week's paper for more on this partnership.






