Welcome, **Alianne**, and please do tell us more about your intriguing **Blood and Shadows** Series!

Q: Please tell us a little about the overall series arc.

The series arc is set in the future, generations after a massive war almost exterminated humanity. It was saved by a controversial genetic chem-treatment, which has become mandatory for every single child right after birth.

However, after so many generations, it's becoming very obvious that these treatments no longer work. People with strange characteristics and abilities begin cropping up, society protests the treatments, but the government will not give them up, because it would mean relinquishing control. They are performing secret experiments on people to find out how they tick, why the chemtreatments aren't working, and how to make them work again. Essentially, how to make people better, to force the hand of Evolution. In a society already on the brink of civil war, the spark of these experiments being made public blows everything sky high. The individual stories of these books follow the results of one such experiment, and its ripple effect.

Q: When you started this series, did you already have a clear vision of the books and characters you wanted to write about? Or did that evolve over time?

In the beginning, I did. Tristan and Dara in BLOOD MOONS came to me in such detail that their story practically told itself. Hailey and Amelia of BLOOD TRAILS and BLOOD DEBTS were also very prominent in my mind. I knew from the beginning that I would want to tell their stories. But their development was very different. Hailey burst onto the scene like a hurricane and left a whole lot of destruction in her wake. Amelia, on the other hand, was the epitome of that saying, "Quiet waters run deep." She appeared in both of the first books, but as a character she was pretty insignificant. Too many secrets she didn't want to share. In her own book, she blossomed into a powerful heroine in her own right, and proved she very much deserved that spotlight and her happy ending.

Emma and John in BLOOD HUNT, on the other hand, came out of nowhere. I had thought the series would be finished once Amelia, the instigator of the experiment, ended her tale. Basically, by withdrawing from the world, Amelia left all the civil unrest behind, but it didn't disappear, just grew worse. Emma and John have the privilege of it blowing up in their faces as the rallies and protest quickly turn into bloody riots and full-out civil war. Oops...

Q:What makes Tristan and Dara perfect for each other in BLOOD MOONS?



The fact that they have no one else to turn to. When the plot begins, Dara has been sentenced to life in prison for something she didn't do, and Tristan is resigned to eventually dying a horrible death from the experiments being done on him. Neither has a hope left in the world, but somehow, when it matters most, they turn to each other and become each other's safe harbor. The hardened, ruthless Tristan becomes the only thing standing between Dara and a very bad fate, and in turn, she becomes Tristan's sanity. She restores his soul and reminds him that he is still human.

Q: Please tell us about Agent Jeremy Calen in BLOOD TRAILS. How did he cope with Hailey, who didn't want to be helped or rescued?


Very badly. LOL. The two of them are complete opposites in personality and general approach to life. Hailey is impetuous, jumps into everything head-first and only thinks about consequences after she's landed. Jeremy, on the other hand, is a buttoned-up professional. He's spent his life taking care of his little sister, and that responsibility has shaped him into a man who cannot afford to take chances. Hailey frustrates him with her impulsiveness; he doesn't know how to deal with it, other than try to make her slow down and think things through before she acts. Hailey reacts violently to that. Her clock is ticking, and she doesn't have time to sit and think, she needs to act, or she won't live through the next month. They butt heads constantly, and every time they do, sparks fly like crazy. The truth is, Jeremy needs someone to ruffle his feathers and make him cut loose, and no matter how much she protests, Hailey needs someone to save her.

Q: What kind of man is Gabriel? What shaped him to be the person we met in BLOOD DEBTS?

Gabriel is a man driven by loss and the need for revenge. He has been pulled into a world where rich people live an elaborate game of make-believe. They have recreated ancient Rome, with all its corruption and cruelty. He has been contracted to kill for the entertainment of the masses, and he goes along with it for the chance to take out the one who has destroyed his life, but he's playing a much bigger game than he realizes. When Amelia inadvertently gets sucked into it along with him, his priorities have to change—he has to get her out safely before he can do anything else, but in Rome, the moment they step foot on the hot sands it's already too late.

Q:In the fourth book, BLOOD HUNT, who are the Shadows? What do they do? Why did John join the Shadows?

The Shadows are a secret private army whose mission is to stand against everyone who opposes their commander in chief, especially telepaths. They are super soldiers, kidnapped, or forcibly drafted at a very young age, and brainwashed to follow orders without question. Until now, the Shadows were something of an urban myth. No one really believed they existed, but rumors kept surfacing, and they were enough to strike fear into people. Now that war is brewing, the time has come for them to show their hand. John Wayland was "recruited" for his unique trait of being resistant to telepathic manipulation. He had no choice in the matter—the Shadows don't exactly take "No" for an answer. Because he can't be corrupted, he indispensable to the Shadows, and they won't give him up.



Q: What is your favorite quote in the series?

This is a quote from BLOOD HUNT. Emma had just woken up from a nightmare, and her mentor is trying to explain some things, but it's not making her feel any better. She goes on this random tirade, and somehow it all coalesces at the end into a merciless accusation that her mentor can't defend against. I love it, because it basically sums up how thoughtless the telepaths had become. This monologue becomes a turning point for them in the book.

"You both built armies. Shadows and Whisper Men. They fight with guns, because they have nothing else. We fight with thoughts and words. We teach, we investigate and counsel, and then we leave. How do you know those people don't hurt? How can they not? We sift through them, take bits and pieces. What if we don't leave enough behind? What if we jumble them so bad, they don't remember who they were? What if they're just like me and they don't even know it? Who are you to say they're wrong to begin with? And we keep fixing, and adjusting, making room for ourselves—and I can't stand it! Who are you to say I'm broken? How dare you tell me I need you! You're the reason they did this to me!"

Q: Among all the characters in the series, major and minor, which is your favorite? Why?



Before BLOOD HUNT, I would have answered Gabriel Connors. I loved his irreverent sense of humor, his intensity and devotion to his mission and his mate. But then I wrote book 4, and in it is a character that appears almost like a ghost, and disappears just as quickly. He has very little "screen time," but boy, does he make great use of it! As one of the unique, nonconforming people, Michael's ability is to calculate the future from among infinite possibilities. He knows what will happen; he even knows when and how people (and he himself!) will die. What I love about him is that he carries the weight of the world on his shoulders. He's one of the very few people who can see the pawns being moved across the chessboard, has every opportunity to alter the future for his own personal gains, but he doesn't. Even if it means great sacrifice, he acts for the good of society. At times it makes him seem almost heartless, but that is very far from the truth.

Q: What scene was most difficult to write, either because of its emotional intensity or level of technical difficulty?

Hmm... I don't have a particular scene, but several. In BLOOD HUNT, Emma Calen goes through a ruthless transformation. She is tortured for weeks, and it affects her mind, changes the way she thinks, perceives, and communicates. She spends a great deal of time being completely incomprehensible, and then slowly comes back to the way she used to be. Or as close as she can get. It would have been so easy to just fill pages with utter nonsense, but it wasn't all nonsense. In her garbled babbles, Emma spoke nugget of profound wisdom, to the point that it rattled John, who was watching it happen. It was an extremely precarious path to walk—making her totally, unequivocally nuts, without turning her into a cartoon character. At her most damaged, she was almost child-like, confused and frightened. But at the same time, her stubborn refusal to submit showed incredible strength of will and maturity. Writing her madness was the easiest thing in the world to accomplish. Showing glimpses of her soul shining through her delirium was probably the most difficult.

Q:Which usually came first for you? Plot or character? Please give us an example.

My plots usually center around the characters, so the characters tend to come first and rile things up. This created an issue for me with BLOOD HUNT, because about halfway through, I introduced a new set of characters who, just by showing up, changed the plot of the book. I spent months going back and rewriting details, scenes, sometimes entire chapters, in order to accommodate them and make the plot consistent, but ultimately, it made the plot so much richer that I can't regret it. These characters added emotional depth to the entire situation, brought the worlds-wide civil unrest down to a very personal level. It wasn't just an abstract view of a society tearing itself apart anymore; it was an inescapable portrait of the people most affected by the conflict. The victims, the forgotten and abandoned. Without them, BLOOD HUNT would be a very different book.

Q: What's up next for you?

My next work in progress is DRAGONBLOOD, the sequel to my high fantasy romance, THE ROYAL WIZARD. The series as a whole is about a

great change happening in the world. The old ways are dying, and a new world will eventually emerge. The first book set the stage. In this second, the consequences begin to take shape. What seems like a personal vendetta turns out to be something much more sinister, and in order to save a people, the hero and heroine must overcome the hatred between their two kingdoms and work together. And not kill each other in the process. It's all great fun. LOL

She closed her eyes absorbing his warmth like she'd been deprived of the noonday sun. "I am part of any world you reside in, Simon. I would follow you anywhere."


