- 14 LEAs and 39 Tier I and Tier II schools
 - 25 Transformation
 - 8 Turnaround
 - 6 Restart
 - 0 Closure
- 2012/13–2014/15
- Approximately \$199 million



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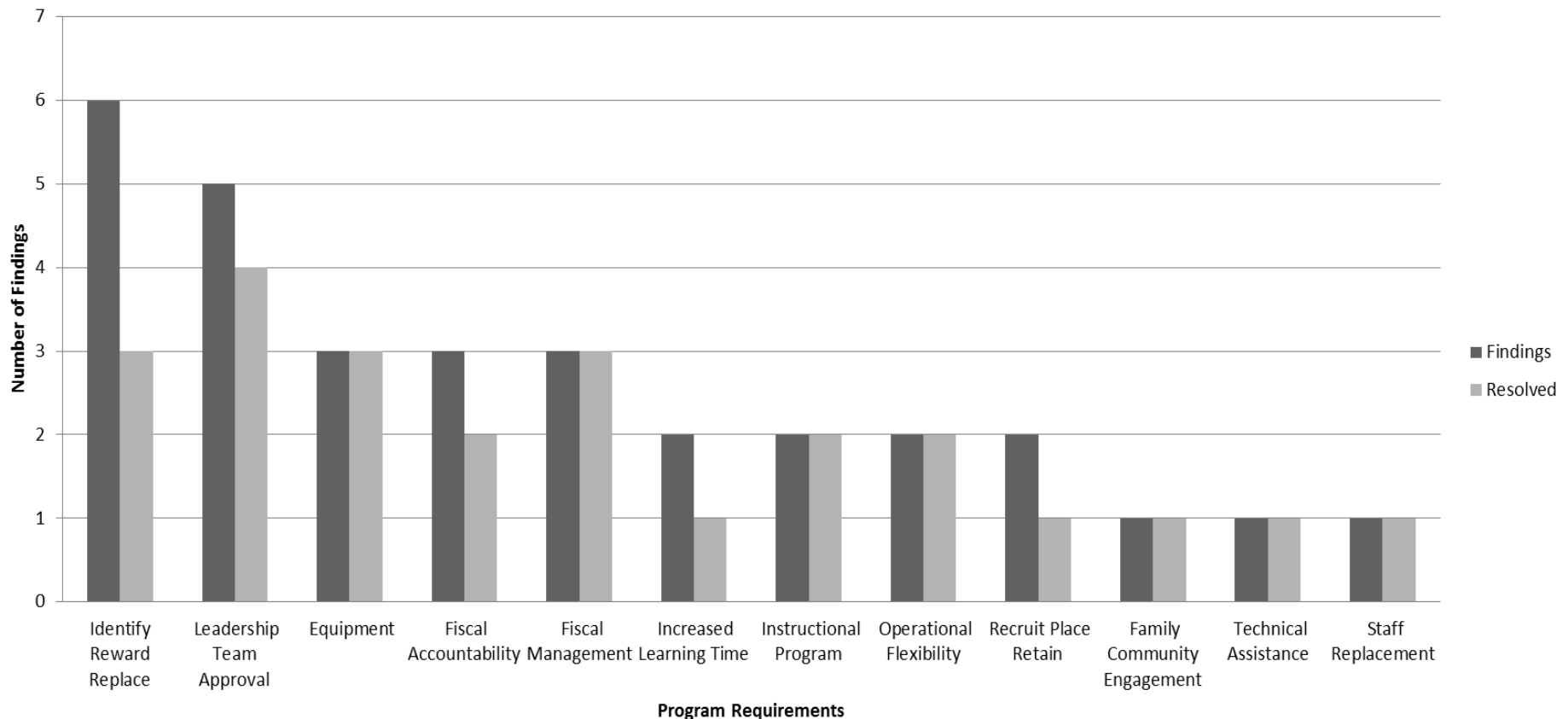
Cohort 2 (cont.)

- Fall 2014 Survey
 - Collective bargaining related to required intervention model components
 - Sustainability of grant initiatives
 - Conflicting initiatives at the LEA-level

- 2014/15–2016/17
- Approximately \$62 million
