

## MUTUAL AID COMMUNICATION AGREEMENT

### S. C. FORESTRY COMMISSION

By this agreement the SC Forestry Commission hereby authorizes the \_\_\_\_\_ Fire Department to use the following mutual-aid frequencies: 154.265MHz, 154.280MHz & 154.295MHz to communicate with fire-fighting personnel of the SC Forestry Commission. Use of these frequencies will be limited to **mutual-aid situations only**—that is, for direct communications between the fire department and the SC Forestry Commission or other authorized units working on a fire or other incident. Use of these frequencies for normal fire department operations is prohibited. The fire department will coordinate with the SC Forestry Commission Ranger on which of the three frequencies will be monitored and used. No PL (CTCSS) tone will be used on these frequencies. This agreement is for mobile radio or handheld radio use only—not for base stations! The fire department will be responsible for complying with all FCC rules. The SCFC reserves the right to terminate this agreement if the signing party does not properly use the frequencies. Communication will be in “clear text” or “plain talk”—no signal codes.
