Why a capital campaign for Quail Creek?

Investment creates beauty, and beauty strengthens our neighborhood. Our two square mile neighborhood which developed over decades has failing walls, deteriorating or nonexistent sprinkler systems and a lack of continuity in design and material for 24 entries. The attention and repair necessary would take more funding than the Quail Community Foundation's total budget could provide over the next 17 years. Additionally, residents have requested more improvements after seeing the success of other recent Foundation projects: the original Quail Creek entry on North May and Quail Creek Road, the three beautifully landscaped islands at the Hefner Road entries and the Browne Stone Road entry.

How did the Quail Community Foundation prepare for the capital campaign?

The Foundation, having developed a concept for the neighborhood, contracted Howard-Fairbain Site Design, Inc. to create a complete and tangible plan for Quail Creek. This plan is a culmination of meetings, research and timeless work with Howard-Fairbain and the Foundation that spans more than a two year period.

Benefits for Quail Creek and Oklahoma City

Developed in 1961 by Jack Johnston, Quail Creek was truly ahead of its time as a planned country club community in Oklahoma City. A two lane, section line road took potential home buyers to far north Oklahoma City to explore the possibilities of a high-end country lifestyle. Our little neighborhood is now in the hub of northwest Oklahoma City life. Tens of thousands of cars pass daily on May Avenue, Northwest 122nd, the Hefner Parkway and the Kilpatrick Turnpike. Quail Creek residents have easy access to everything a 21st century family desires. Reinvesting in our neighborhood enhances the quality of life for residents, increases property values for all homes as well as beautifying and stabilizing northwest Oklahoma City.
