Christchurch Stands Tall is an exciting new event for the city in Summer 2014/15.

The project brings together businesses, artists and schools to create a spectacular world-class sculpture trail across Christchurch and surrounding areas.

Wild in Art has been producing public art events in cities across the world for the last seven years. We bring the creativity and enjoyment of art to thousands of people through our high profile events and education activity. Since 2008, we have engaged over 30,000 children across 1,000 schools through our education projects.

From November 2014 to January 2015 a tower of brightly coloured life-sized Giraffe sculptures painted by local artists and their small calves decorated by local schools will gallop onto the streets, parks and public spaces as part of a mass public art exhibition to help bring fun and interest into every area of the city and shout to the world that Christchurch is standing tall.

The Schools Programme is an integral part of the Christchurch Stands Tall project. Not only is this an exciting

opportunity to showcase your students' creativity but it is a great way to get involved in an engaging city wide event that everyone can enjoy.

Each participating school will get to design and decorate their own giraffe calf, plus you will receive the Christchurch Stands Tall cross curricular education pack to help bring giraffes, citizenship, the environment, our city and producing artwork into the classroom in a fun and engaging way.

At the end of the event, each Giraffe calf will be returned to its school for you to keep. The large sized Giraffe sculptures will go under the hammer at a charity auction to raise critical funding for the following charities working in the city:



How does the event work?

- Businesses, community groups, charities, education establishments and individuals are invited to sponsor a blank Giraffe sculpture – the canvas.
- Artists, well known and undiscovered, young and old, are invited to submit their designs. The best designs will be selected by sponsors to feature on the Christchurch Stands Tall trail.
- Local schools will also be able to adopt and decorate their own Giraffe calf sculpture to feature on the trail which will be theirs to keep at the end of the event. Plus you will also receive a Giraffe themed curriculum-linked education pack to help bring giraffes, citizenship and our city into the classroom.
- Up to 52 large sized Giraffes along with up to 50 small school sculptures will go on display across Christchurch and surrounding areas, forming a spectacular sculpture trail for all to enjoy.
- After the event, the large sculptures will be sold at auction with 75% of the net proceeds going to the charities above.

- A Dulux paint pack, containing a suite of bright and exciting colours to be used on your sculpture.
