Instructions for Completing the Letter of Apology

Your letters of apology must address the following concerns in order to be accepted by the Court.

- 2. Take responsibility for your actions. State what you did. What role did you play? Remember not to blame others!
- 3. Put yourself in the victim's place. How would you feel if this action was done to you?
- 4. How do you feel about what you did? What could you have done differently!

REMEMBER: FAILURE to complete the above instructions and letter may result in the letter being returned for corrections, a Further Dispositional Orders hearing before the Court, and/or charges filed.
