We are grateful to God for our faithful volunteers and financial partners for such an amazing year of ministry at the PRC of Metro Richmond in 2015. It was a joy to witness 67 clients become believers in Jesus Christ and to rejoice with an increasing number of clients who decided to carry their babies to birth! Thank you for your prayers and for serving with us!

It's a new year! Let's pray for increased opportunities to serve more young moms, dads, and babies! Let's ask God to make a way for young moms and dads to hear about and come to the PRC for option counseling and limited medical services before they make any life altering termination decisions regarding their pregnancy.

Recently a client shared with us that what was most helpful to her about her visit was... <u>a lot of very good information, great</u> <u>starting point for figuring out what steps to take to get help during pregnancy. There are so many resources to help and staff</u> <u>is very good natured and pleasant.</u>

Our strategic goals for this year are to connect with at risk women like the 4,800 women who terminated their pregnancies at the three abortions providers within just a few miles of the PRC of Metro Richmond in 2014. These moms, dads, preborn babies, and families are in vital need of our life-affirming services. Now is the time to close the gap and implement our comprehensive plan to strategically reach this underserved population.

Over the last decade we have trusted God and worked purposefully and diligently to develop services that are both life affirming and life impacting. We have built relationships within our local city and county with health departments, social services departments, community leaders, and health care service providers. We are grateful so many of these refer clients to us.

In 2014 we updated our logo. In 2015 we launched a new client web site, increased our search engine optimization, and added Birth of a Family to help build strong biblical families as we mentor young moms and dads. Clients have repeatedly shared with us how the services that PRC of Metro Richmond provides have positively impacted their lives.

<u>I felt loved, valued and was treated with respect. The counselor asked good questions and provided great information of things that I had not ever considered regarding pregnancy. Every pregnant woman should have the opportunity to receive help from this place. PRC Client</u>

ULTRASOUND UPDATE By Lynn Bisbee, RNC, WHNP: Nurse Manager

In 2015 Staff Nurse Pat Hague, RN and I provided 445 ultrasounds. This made a grand total of 5129 It's an exciting milestone to have done over 5000 ultrasounds, and we are so grateful to God for giving us these many opportunities to serve women in the Metro Richmond area with much needed medical services.

Our client demographics show that we minister to women from a wide variety of ages and backgrounds. Our ultrasound clients have been as young as 12 and as old as 41. Most are between the ages of 20-24, and most are single. The clients' ethnic backgrounds include African American, Caucasian, Latina, Arab, Asian, European, and others. We serve the nations!

Our clients are economically diverse as well. While the majority of clients we see are urban women with limited incomes, we also serve students who have resources but don't want their parents or anyone else to know about their pregnancies. Some of our married clients are unemployed, or their husbands are without jobs. Many are new to Richmond or the United States and are unaware of our community resources.

Numerous clients profess a Christian faith, and some are Muslims, Hindus, Agnostics or Atheists. Within our diverse population many of the women we serve are unsure of their plans for their pregnancies, and a small percent decide to have abortions.

Yet this one thing they have in common, they all want excellent information and care for their situation. They want a safe place to talk about options and receive answers to their pregnancy related health care questions. The clients' exit questionnaires tell us they appreciate our free medical services and non-judgmental, authentic support.

Most importantly, as we provide medical services, we look for opportunities to share our faith and the "living water" that Jesus offers our clients. Our hope is to make a difference in the women's lives, not only for their medical needs and for the lives of their babies, but also for eternity.

MIRACLE OF LIFE By Rebecca Jones: Assistant Center Director

Katie^{*} came to the PRC for a pregnancy test. She was planning to have an abortion, and her client advocate lovingly and nonjudgingly ministered to her. Katie declined to take any brochures home, and her client advocate respected her decision. She did however allow her client advocate to pray with her. Two weeks later Katie came back for her ultrasound, still planning to have an abortion.

When a client comes for an ultrasound, the nurse offers for her to meet with a client advocate afterwards. At first, Katie did not want to meet with a client advocate after the ultrasound, but she began sobbing in the crowded waiting room while waiting for her boyfriend, Will,* who was meeting with a male mentor. A client advocate asked Katie if she would like to wait in a quiet place. Katie agreed and gave the client advocate permission to sit with her in the counseling room. She was still considering abortion as she left, but was now undecided. Katie didn't want to look at or take the abortion procedures and risk brochure. Will did give permission for his client advocate to share the abortion procedures and risk brochure and took it with him.

Katie and Will now had three client advocates and the nurse praying specifically for them and their child, along with other staff members and client advocates who had seen Katie's tears.

About two weeks later, Katie and Will walked back into the center. Katie explained that she wanted to speak to someone and get the information she had refused before. I met with Katie, and she shared that she was going to parent! I had the joy of sharing parenting resources and offering encouragement. The Holy Spirit had worked with Katie and Will, using the information shared by the previous client advocates, to turn their hearts toward their child (Luke 1:7).

Katie and Will were back a week later for their PERC intake and have become faithful attendees of our Parenting Class. They were blessed by the PRC Christmas Angel program, and their baby will be born in just a few short weeks.

At least eight volunteers and staff members interacted directly with this couple, which is a perfect example of 1 Corinthians 3:6-8 – many people sowed and watered seeds and God gave the increase. This is just one of the many miracles that occurs at the PRC because God's people pray, give, and serve, and God works within our clients' hearts.

I believe the staff and volunteers at the PRC already do this, and I am excited to join in on what God is already doing through them and this ministry.

2015 prc annual gala **GOD HONORING EVENT**

The PRC of Metro Richmond hosted its 2015 annual gala on November 19th at the Richmond Marriott. It was a God honoring evening as approximately 500 PRC friends and supporters came together to fellowship and encourage each other to stand for life.



Kim Warburton, Executive Director, shared in her ministry update how God continues to use the PRC to build a culture of compassion and faith in our community and how PRC staff and volunteers are working to pro-



mote a culture of sexual integrity and helping to build strong biblical families. Kim shared that, moving into 2016, PRC has a God-sized vision to be a woman's first choice in an unplanned pregnancy and the strategic plan to make that vision a reality.

Guests received a double blessing from keynote speakers, David and Jason Benham. The twin brothers tag-teamed their way through their speech, challenging guests to understand that the problem in our world is not the presence of darkness but the absence of light. We are all called to be the Light of Christ in our community and the brothers encouraged us to stop being lightening bugs but instead be lightening bolts.



David and Jason boldly declared that abortion is not just an issue, it is the issue. Where you stand on life is where you stand on everything. They also reminded us that God's blessings are only found within God's boundaries. When you remove God's boundaries ,His blessings are replaced with burdens.



The evening came to a fitting conclusion as Margaret Wilson, wife of Board member Dr. Rick Wilson, led us in singing Amazing Grace, My Chains Are Gone.
