- All contracts are for 30 paid hours with a 10 hour "volunteer / generosity" clause for a total of 40 hours per week.
- You will be responsible for the animation of the "FaithSpace" lesson to your group (lesson plan provided).
- Starting salary is the minimum wage set by law. Different salaries for different positions (Assistants, Animators, Coordinators, etc...).
- The city law requires all new staff to take part in a two day first aid training program. We will cover some of the fee (Returning staff 1 day).
- Please STAPLE to application, a recent photocopied school transcript (city protocols). Please black out your marks.
- All new staff (18 years over) will be subject to a police check.
- You must be 16 years old once camp begins to be considered a paid staff (City regulations).
- Camp formation will begin on Tuesday, April 12th. They are mostly on Tuesday nights and are compulsory.
- As part of your training program, you will be required to have a leadership presence at one of the YLC's big events. You have the choice of the Fashion Festival on Sunday, May 8th or our Street Ball Hockey tournament on Saturday, May 21st. Both are full day requirements.
- There is also a SLR (Salesian Leadership retreat) weekend scheduled on June 3rd, 4th, 5th. It is compulsory for all new staff that are officially hired. Some returning staff will be asked to lead.
- The YLC's focus is developing positive and visible leaders for our camps, the YLC and the community at large. The camp is "Catholic based" as is the YLC. We will invite, journey and challenge you to explore your spirituality in an open, interactive and nurturing way throughout the animator training, summer and the year. If you are not open to this approach, we ask you respectfully not to apply.
- Camp this year is a 6 week program with an optional week. Animator contracts are for 6 or 7 weeks. Other contracts vary in weeks.
- Please take note that priority is given to those who can commit to a minimum of 5 weeks of work. Work hours are from 8:30am to 4:30pm.
 Camp pay work begins Monday, June 28^{7h} and ends on Friday, August 12th. The OPTIONAL CAMP WEEK is from Monday, July 25th to
- Friday, July 29th (First week of construction holiday). Some staff will be asked to work while others will have some days off.
- All staff that is welcomed to our training meetings is hired on condition of camper registrations and performance at the meetings. At the end of May, we will officially hire our staff. All those who cannot be part of the team for the above conditions will receive a "Summer Camp Training Certification" if merited for future employment and their personal records.
- We are developing leaders for our immediate future...with you in mind!!!
