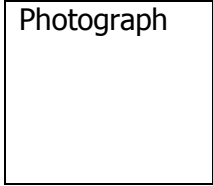

Subject: Farm Mechanization Interface under NeGP-Agriculture


Sir / Madam,

Farm Mechanization plays a critical role in increasing agricultural productivity. Presently, farmers are often dependent on Government officials and specific sellers in their vicinity to get information about machinery / equipment required by them for various agricultural operations pertaining to crops grown by them. **In order to make entire data available transparently on the web, Farm Mechanization Module has been integrated in the Farmers' Portal.** This interface involves all stakeholders including the Government of India, State Governments, State Agro Industries Corporations, Machinery Manufacturers Associations, Farm Machinery Testing and Training Institutes (FMTTIs), manufacturers, traders and dealers. Broad features of this software can be summarised as follows:-

- Registration of manufacturers either directly or through associations/FMTTIs etc.
- Data entry of details of products (including additional technical features, price, service centres, test reports etc. by the manufacturers) and basic information about dealers.
- Dealer login interface wherein it can enter price of various products (of various manufacturers) which may be different from Suggested Retail Price (SRP) indicated by the manufacturers. Specific terms of after sales-service can also be mentioned.
- Rent and other related terms and conditions in case of hiring of different kinds of machinery by the farmers for specific operations.
- **Most of the farmers in rural areas do not have direct access to internet. Therefore, an application based on Unstructured Supplementary Service Data (USSD) has also been developed, wherein a registered farmer can dial *491*103# (and choose Option 7) to get details about the machinery required by him / her. Similarly, dealers not having internet access can also carry out data entry using USSD.**

The software is now fully developed and tested thoroughly by various stakeholders and is ready to be rolled out. The software enables free and informed choice of machinery by the farmer. Work is going on for other two aspects viz. objective & transparent selection of beneficiaries under various schemes, work-flow based approval process and flow of subsidy directly in to farmer's bank account. Procedural details for accessing various modules have been given in Annexure to this letter. User Manuals of various modules are available on respective login pages along with screen shots, so as to clarify steps involved in data entry by various stakeholders.


Overall progress of data entry can be dynamically seen by accessing link <http://farmer.gov.in/DataEntryReport.aspx> having drill-down facility. All stakeholders are requested to complete data entry on priority basis within next 10 days as this web based software is likely to be launched by the Hon'ble Agriculture Minister in the month of April, 2015 only.

Procedural Details for Accessing Various Modules

A- Authentication Authorities:

- 1. Associations and FMTTIs:** The login page can be reached from www.farmer.gov.in (Login >> Farm Machinery >> Authentication Authority >> Association and FMTTI). Bulk data entry for the basic details of Manufacturer/Trader can be done by selecting Association name as login. The default password is *Farm@2014#*. All these Manufacturers and Traders entered by Associations and FMTTIs shall be treated as authenticated. The data entry is to be done State-wise after considering registered office of the manufacturer. An alert message will go to the Manufacturer/Trader on the mobile number entered by the Association/FMTTI showing the manufacturer ID as login ID and the default password. An in-built check has been introduced in the software to avoid duplicate entry as PAN / TIN Number of a manufacturer has to be unique.

The association may also authenticate or reject the Manufacturers/Traders which have registered themselves. **Only authenticated / approved Manufacturer/Trader can enter details of their dealers, services and products.**

- 2. State Governments:** The login page can be reached from www.farmer.gov.in (Login >> Farm Machinery >> Authentication Authority >> State). Select your state as login. The default password is *Farm@2014#*. The procedure is same as described above.

B- Manufacturer/Trader:

- 1. New Registration:** The login page can be reached from <http://farmer.gov.in> (Login >> Farm Machinery >> Manufacturer/Trader >> New Registration). Choose the State of Corporate/Head Office and enter the basic details, manufacturing unit details, product details, product price, service centres, product testing details etc. After getting registered, the Manufacturer/Trader will get an ID on screen as well as by SMS and e-mail for future login purposes with default password *abc@1234#* (where 'abc' are the first three digits of the TIN / PAN

number). An alert message and e-mail will go to Authenticating Authority concerned for authentication purpose.

2. Already Registered: The login page can be reached from <http://farmer.gov.in> (Login >> Farm Machinery >> Manufacturer/Trader >> Registered). The Manufacturer/Trader may add new products and change the details of existing products after successful login. **Only authenticated / approved Manufacturer/Trader can enter their dealer's detail.** Authenticated Manufacturer/Trader may enter new dealer, select existing own dealer or the dealer of other Manufacturer/Trader for mapping the products and other related information. **It is also informed that there are 1861 dealers already in the Farmers' Portal database with which no manufacturer is currently mapped.** The manufacturers can use this list of 1861 dealers also to carry out the mapping. Option of edit to enter the fields not entered earlier (e.g. TIN / PAN number) has also been provided. Even if these new fields like TIN / PAN number is not entered, such dealers can still be mapped for all purposes except for login by the dealer. These dealers will also be shown in the list. An alert through SMS will go to the dealer concerned on his/her registered mobile number entered by the manufacturer.

C- Dealer:

The login page can be reached from <http://farmer.gov.in>(Login >> Farm Machinery >> Dealer). The login ID will be the TIN / PAN No. of Dealer and default password will be *abc@1234#* (where abc is the first three digits of the TIN / PAN No of Dealer). Dealers registered by Manufacturers/Traders only will be able to log in. After log in, the dealer will be able to see the all the mapped products of manufacturer/trader and can offer special price, hiring options etc.

D- M& T Division of DAC:

Log in from <http://farmer.gov.in> (Login >> Farm Machinery >> M & T Division). Options for updating of master tables, monitoring of data entry progress and various reports are available after login. User id and password have been conveyed separately.

Note: All passwords can be changed on first log in or any time thereafter.
