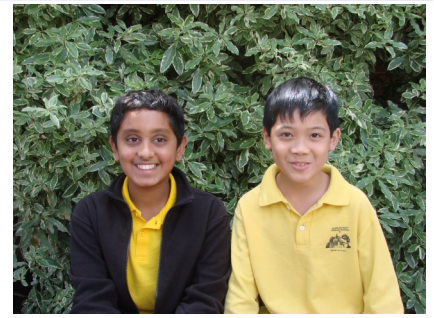

Dear Members of the Burwood East Primary School Community,

Welcome Back! I hope that you have all had a fantastic holiday and are relaxed and ready for the year ahead. I would like to extend a very warm welcome to our new students and their families – we have a wonderful community here at BEPS and we are very happy to have you join us. Welcome back also to our staff, particularly those who are joining us for the first time this year, Rochelle Moss, Meg Brouwer, Blake Sahlstrom and Susie Tinker.

We are looking forward to a productive partnership with you to ensure all children can achieve their highest potential. We recognize that in order to be successful in school, our children need support from both the home and school. We know a strong partnership with you will make a great difference in your child's education. As partners, we share the responsibility for our children's success and want you to know that we will do our very best to carry out our responsibilities. We ask that you guide and support your child's learning by ensuring that he/she:

- 1) Attends school daily and arrives on time, ready for the day's learning experience
- 2) Completes all homework assignments given by teachers
- 3) Reads daily to develop a love for reading and to improve Literacy skills
- 4) Shares school experiences with you so that you are aware of his / her school life

There are many opportunities for parent involvement within the school: classroom assistance with Reading, Maths or PMP; volunteering to help with athletics; assisting at Working Bees; and of course, being a member of the Parents Association who do such an amazing job of raising funds for the school and creating a caring culture with a range of events throughout the year.

A dynamic School Council is a vital component of any school and we are looking for parents to join the 2015 Council. Parental support of the teachers and the school's programs is also vital and includes displaying a positive attitude towards your child's learning, so I encourage you all to be fully involved in your child's education.

I remind all members of the community that my door is always open to hear any cares, concerns or compliments. All classroom teachers are available for informal meetings before school @ 8:50am, but if you feel you need more than 10 minutes (as instruction begins at 9am) you can make an appointment for a mutually convenient time either before school or after school.

I would also like to remind everyone that school drop off and pick up times are generally extremely busy so for the safety of all of our students please observe the parking and cross-

ing arrangements. We have been requested by DEECD to alert parents/carers about speed limits in designated school speed zones during specified times i.e. 8.00—9.30am and 2.30—4.00pm

Our newsletter is published every fortnight and is one of our major avenues of communication with parents. As well as containing important information about what is happening at school, there is a calendar in which you will find brief details regarding future events.

#### **Classroom Fruit Program (Brain Food)**

As adults we acknowledge the importance of eating fresh fruit and vegetables on a daily basis and also the significant role they undertake in growing bodies – particularly when learning is occurring at the same time. At 10 o'clock the children will stop and have a piece of fruit in order to replenish their vitamins and minerals and we would appreciate it if families could support this by ensuring their child brings a piece of fruit or cut-up vegetables such as carrot sticks or celery to school every day. If you have any questions about Brain Food please do not hesitate to see your child's teacher or myself.

##### 4 EASY STEPS TO ONLINE SCHOOL PHOTO ORDERING

- **Step 1:** Go to [www.advancedlife.com.au](http://www.advancedlife.com.au) before photo day and enter your school code [L6C V4V TF2]
- **Step 2:** Enter your student's details
- **Step 3:** Choose the package that best suits your needs (all orders will be returned to the school for collection).
- **Step 4:** Pay for the photos via the shopping cart (upper right corner of the page).
- **Please Note:** Late fees will apply once orders are closed (5 days after photo day).

#### Our Food + Menu

Our food is simple, fresh, healthy, tasty and delicious. Yum! Our food is 'homestyle' made with passion by us! We understand the importance of nutritious food that encourages children to eat healthy. We closely follow the Victorian Government nutrition guidelines for schools - our menu is 'Go For Your Life' approved. Each season we change our Menu.

#### What you need to do

You will need to set up your account using our online service. This must be done before you can order your child's lunch. We use FlexiSchools. Follow these steps to set up your account:

1. Go to [www.misspeppercorn.com.au/schools](http://www.misspeppercorn.com.au/schools)
2. Click on "Click here to register" to create your account
3. Top-up your balance
4. Start ordering immediately - we are open!
5. Each time you order you can select our 'allergy alert' option which will print on your child's label and advise our kitchen of the relevant allergy.

#### What Does it Cost?

The cost is the cost as shown on the menu plus a 25c fee for each order placed.

#### What payment methods can I use?

FlexiSchools accepts payment via Visa, Mastercard, Payclick and Bank Transfer. To perform a bank transfer to your FlexiSchools account, click 'Topup Account' when logged into the FlexiSchools website and select 'Bank Transfer'; you will be given your unique EFT code. You can then make a transfer via your bank's internet facility or at your branch. Your Account must have a minimum of \$20 in it.

#### Monthly Specials and Meal Deals

Our regular specials and meal deals will be emailed to you each month. We look forward to providing your children their lunch.

#### How Does It Work?

Go to

<https://www.misspeppercorn.com.au/school-lunches/> and click "click here to register". Then enter your student's name, school and class, and add funds (say \$50) into a pre-paid account.

You can log into the website at any time to place orders, up until 9:15am on the day of the order. As purchases are made, the funds are taken from your pre-paid account. The account can be topped up again in the same way, or set to automatically top-up via credit card when the balance falls below a pre-set minimum.

Each order is sent automatically to our kitchen, where an easy-to-read label is produced with the student's name, class and order details.

At lunch time, we take the orders to your school and collate them ready for collection.
