According to the law, males must register with Selective Service within 30 days of their 18th birthday. Selective Services will not accept registration from men 26 years old or older. Men who did not register for selective services during the time they were eligible can be denied federal financial aid.

Non-registrants may appeal if they can show that failure to register was not knowing and willful. Non-registrants must offer evidence supporting their claim with as much detail as possible.

- Status Information Letter from Selective Service, available at www.sss.gov or by calling 1-847-688-6888.
- Detailed, typed personal statement explaining reason for failing to register as required by federal law.
- Supporting documentation, letters from a third-party supporting your claim, I-94, entry documents, refugee documents, etc.
