## **EQUIPMENT TRUST FUND**

### **COMMUNITY CONTROLLED**

ESTABLISHED DECEMBER 1989

Education should be considered to be a community cost. It is in the interests of the whole community to support high quality education.

### ***THE TRUST FUND – A NECESSITY?***

Government grants and school fees only cover the basic operating costs of providing the present curriculum. Provision for replacement and upgrading of equipment is not necessarily funded by the Government.

In recent years the school has provided a diverse curriculum so that as far as possible all students with different levels of scholastic ability acquire the best education that we as a community can provide.

Since 1993, the fund has purchased items for the school to the value of \$78 259.00.

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**FOR OUR STUDENTS TO RECEIVE A CONTINUING HIGH STANDARD OF EDUCATION, COMMUNITY FUNDING AND SUPPORT IS ESSENTIAL.**

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### ***THE TRUST FUND – How does it work?***

A Trust has been established which is managed by a Board of Trustees comprising three High School Councillors, three community minded persons and the Chairman of the District Council or his/her nominee.

The Trustees will, on an annual basis, allocate a proportion of the earnings of the fund to the school to help the purchase of approved plant and equipment.

The Fund will always be owned by the local community and unlike other school monies, will not be at the direction of the Minister of Education.

### ***THE TRUST FUND – Aims and Objectives***

1. To maintain a high standard of education with up-to-date equipment and facilities.
2. To have a fund that the community controls without Government interference.
3. To purchase new equipment and upgrade facilities to meet the changing curriculum needs of the community.
4. To maintain a fund that in real terms can meet replacement costs as required for many years into the future.

### ***THE TRUST FUND – How can you assist?***

1. By having your name recorded in our Donor Book as a Fund Contributor in recognition of your cash donation.
2. Fundraising for the fund or by attending fundraising activities conducted for the fund.
3. By becoming a sponsor of the fund:
  - Major sponsor \$5,000 or more
  - Corporate & Business Sponsor \$1,000
  - Private sponsor \$500.
4. Bequests are welcome.

Note – Commitments could be spread over a five year period.
