8 TH GRADE END-OF-YEAR FUN DAY	Work with committee chair to plan and carry out. April 2015 (usually last week).
8 TH GRADE PICTURES	Assist photographers with students. February 2015. Retakes March 2015.
BOOK FAIR	Assist LMC committee chair with fair. Flyers, set up, sales, take down.
DIRECTORY DISTRIBUTION	Assist committee chair with sorting and distribution. October 2014.
PICTURE DAY	Assist photographers with students. September 2014. Retakes October 2014.

ALTERNATIVE FUNDING	Assist in planning and promoting family nights at local restaurants. Goal is one night every other month.
COMMUNITY SERVICE	As a committee, brainstorm and carry out or assist students in carrying out service projects for the Crone community.
LMC (LIBRARY MEDIA CENTER)	Sign up for time slots with committee chair throughout the year to assist the LMC.
REFLECTIONS	Promote the program. Collect entries. Arrange for judging. Hold reception for participants and winners. Sep 2014-Jan 2015.
