## Official Rules

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1. Eligibility:

Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen and either a Shopko teammate or a dependant child of a Shopko teammate. (The dependant child must be under the age of 24 as of July 1, 2011.) Applicants who are children of Shopko teammates must be dependent on the Shopko teammate for over 50% of their cost of living. The applicant or parent of the applicant must be employed by Shopko either part-time or full-time for at least one year of continuous service as of January 1, 2011.

The teammate must be in good standing with Shopko as defined in the Teammate Conduct Policy.

The applicants must be high school seniors or graduates who plan to enroll or are already enrolled in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-or four-year college, university, vocational, or technical school for the entire 2011-12 academic year.

2. How to Enter:

Complete the scholarship application form. All sections of the application must be completed for the applicant to be eligible. A **current official transcript** of the applicant's grades, certified by the school, must accompany the application. Photocopies will not be accepted.

Applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2011. Shopko is not responsible for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible applications or postage-due mail. All applications become the property of Shopko.

By submitting an application, applicants agree to provide other information and documentation as may be reasonably requested by the selection committee.

3. Judging:

Scholarship recipients are selected based on academic record, leadership, and participation in school and community activities, work experience, a statement of educational and career goals, and an applicant recommendation.

Individuals can only be awarded a maximum of four scholarships.

4. Recipient Notification/Claiming Scholarships:

Recipients will be notified by May 15, 2011. All recipients must sign and return the Scholarship Acknowledgement Form and a Publicity Release included with the award notification. Award of scholarship is subject to verification of enrollment from an accredited institution for the upcoming school year. In the event a recipient does not graduate from high school, drops out of high school, or does not enroll in an accredited institution for study during the coming school year, the scholarship will be forfeited and, where practical, awarded to an alternate recipient.

Shopko requires a receipt from the accredited institution of tuition and fees paid by the scholarship award.

5. Scholarships:

Payment of up to \$2,500 shall be awarded. Payments will be made in one installment by July 15, 2011. Checks are mailed directly to the school indicated on the Scholarship Acknowledgment Form and made payable to the school on behalf of the student. Awards are for one year only.

6. Additional Terms:

Taxes on awards are the sole responsibility of the recipients. By participating, entrants agree:

- a. to the Official Rules and decisions of the Selection Committee which shall be final in all respects,
- b. (where legal) to the use of their names and/or likenesses for advertising, promotional, and publicity purposes without written consent or compensation; and
- c. to release, discharge, and hold harmless the Shopko Foundation and the Selection Committee from damages arising out of, in any way, their participation in this program.

7. Scholarship Restrictions:

No substitutions or transfers permitted. Scholarships are to be used to cover institution costs and fees. In the event institution costs and fees are less than the scholarship amount, the balance of the scholarship may be used for other education costs such as course materials, books and on- or off-campus housing. The Selection Committee reserves the right to interpret these rules and to make decisions concerning the award, acceptance and use of scholarships in situations not covered by these rules.
