


HELPFUL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS: Directions to Camp

Camp Nooteeming

From the East: Take I-84 to Taconic Parkway North to Exit for Rte 44. Make a Left (West towards Poughkeepsie) approximately 3 miles to Creek Road. Turn Right onto Creek Road go about 3 miles, proceed through the intersection. The road is now Scout Road. Continue to the camp entrance which will be on the Right.

From the West: Newburgh-Beacon Bridge to I-84 and follow instructions above. OR Route 9W North to the Mid-Hudson Bridge, to Poughkeepsie and Route 44 East. Continue on Rte 44 to Pleasant Valley; approximately 1 mile past the village center, turn Left onto Creek Road. Go about 3 miles, proceed through the intersection. The road is now Scout Road. Continue to the camp entrance which will be on the Right. (Commercial vehicles, trucks and trailers are not allowed on the Palisades or Taconic Parkways. Please call for alternate directions.)

You will be e-mailed a confirmation letter with a detailed list of what to bring to camp along with a Health History Form for each Cub Scout and each parent/adult. Bring the health forms with you to camp, filled out and signed by a parent or guardian; state law will not allow you to attend without this Health History Form completed and at the camp that weekend.

Please specify on the reservation form which program (Wolf, Bear, Webelos I or II) your son will be choosing, based on the grade he will be entering in September 2007. Webelos must also choose an Activity Badge preference. Rank his preferences from most wanted (1) to least (3). Mark an X for any Badge he has already earned.
