# Information about The Buck Mansion

The Buck Mansion was built in 1891 and in listed on the National Register of Historic Places and currently serves as the offices for the Buck Foundation.

The Buck family settled in Vacaville in 1874 and formed the FRANK H. BUCK COMPANY, a fruit grower and packager, in 1886. The company grew a variety of fruit, including cherries, grapes and citrus, and became best known for their peaches and pears. The Buck Company contributed to the development of the refrigerated train car and was the first U.S. company to ship fruit both nationally and globally The Great Depression was a contributing factor that prompted the family to sell the company in 1933.

#### Gates & Parking
