Behavior and Discipline Expectations

Students

The same standards of behavior expected during school hours are also expected for all rehearsals, workshops Tech Week and performances. Persistent behavior that is disruptive, disrespectful or inappropriate, as determined by the director or any supervising adult will have the following repercussions:

- ★ First Incident: A verbal warning will be issued. The behavior will be discussed with the child, and recorded in the behavior log.
- ★ Second Incident: The behavior will be discussed with the child and recorded. The Site Producer or Kid Tech Director will call the child's parent to discuss the behavior.
- ★ Third Incident: A parent or other adult will be requested to attend rehearsals or workshops to supervise the child.
- **★** Fourth Incident: Removal from the Cast or Tech without tuition reimbursement.

Any child committing physical violence or destruction of property, will be expelled from the production without warning and without right of appeal.

Students on LOP (Loss of Privilege) will not be permitted to participate.

<u>Adults</u>

When working with students in YES Theater adults are **expected to use positive means of guidance**, **direction and discipline.** Threats, humiliation, shaming, put-downs and screaming are not tolerated. If an adult feels overwhelmed with a student or a situation, they should ask another supervising adult to help. A creative team member should always have an adult volunteer present to help with supervision. Supervising adults need to be engaged with the children and should not be socializing with other adults. Clear expectations should be set and followed through according to the behavior and discipline policies listed above and set forth by YES Theater. All behavior incidents should be immediately communicated to the site producer. Site producers will contact parents if needed. Never under any circumstance should anyone touch or grab a child in a rough or inappropriate manner.

Attendance

Cast members are expected to attend all audition workshops, auditions, rehearsals, all of tech week and all performances for their cast.

Kid Tech members are expected to attend all tech workshops, all scheduled tech rehearsals, all of tech week and all performances for both casts.

Illness is the only excused absence. If a child misses school for illness they may not attend rehearsal or workshops. Repeated absences can lead to loss of lines, a part or privilege of participation.
